Public Clone Resources and Clone Distributors

Introduction

Large-scale genomic projects by the research community and in industry have created comprehensive cDNA clone resources for many organisms that are publically available for conducting research. Those clones can be obtained from commercial providers or different clone distributors, which commonly offer copies of the clones on a fee-for-service basis. The rights to use the clones may be restricted by an agreement set forward by the owner of the clone resource. Most clone providers offer their own online database to conduct clone searches and to order clones of interest. Note that clones from those resources commonly require manipulation or sub-cloning steps before they can be used in protein expression.
